

Part Time Non-Commissioned Security Officer

Physical, drug test and psych test are required.

Duties

- Patrols Stark Foundation properties on recurring basis as scheduled to ensure that doors, gates and other entrances are properly fastened after hours and that perimeters of properties are secure
- Performs security checks of Stark Foundation properties and assets; reports potential or actual security breaches to management
- Responds to alarms or issues involving Stark Foundation facilities or venues
- Maintains written logs and records of incidents and events occurring during shift
- Provides visual deterrent to illicit or illegal activities through on-site presence and regular patrols

Required Education, Experience and Skills

- High school graduate equivalent
- The following additional education is desired but not required:
Texas Commission on Law Enforcement approved training; equivalent training through another state (non-Texas) program; or Military Police Training
- Military, police, related law enforcement experience, or prior security experience desired.
- Minimum age (21) as set by the Texas Private Security Bureau
- Security Officers must have and maintain physical fitness and ability to perform the essential job duties and to respond to emergency situations at all times.
- The employee must be fit for duty based on the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory (MMPI-2®) which will be administered by an independent consultant.
- Requires standing/sitting for extended periods of time
- Ability to lift or carry up to 50 pounds
- Endurance during exertion of efforts
